Dear parent/carer,

We hope this letter finds you well. Please find below the outline for **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> June)** when we will be welcoming Year 6 pupils into school. The aim of the week is primarily to support the transition of children from Year 6 into Year 7 in these particularly challenging times. With this in mind, there will be a focus on PHSCE tasks about leaving primary school and taking the step up to secondary school. We do anticipate that this may be an emotional week for your child (and you!) so do please speak to us with any concerns.

If you have chosen not to send your child to school, we respect this decision and there will be no sanction for non-attendance. Any children who have not attended school will be able to collect the resources from the week on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June to support learning at home and to help your child prepare for returning to school as a Year 7 pupil.

Throughout the week, the children will be taught in the hall as this allows us to maintain a suitable distance between each child. We will ensure children wash their hands regularly through the day and have procedures in place, outlined below, to support social distancing where possible. While social distancing **will be prioritised**, please be aware that we **CANNOT** guarantee your child will be 2m away from other children and staff at all times.

It is important that you are aware of the following information for next week:

- Please wear school uniform
- Do not bring anything into school – pens, pencils etc will be provided.
- Meals will be provided for children free of charge- please see the menu below. If lunchboxes are brought in, they will need to be sanitised in school, so please avoid this if possible.
- Personal drinks bottles will be available for each child throughout the day, please do not send in bottles from home.
- Unacceptable conduct or behaviour will result in your child being sent home to ensure the safety of others.

At the end of the week, each child will receive a home learning pack to continue their learning and preparation for Year 7 at home. If you have any questions or concerns relating to the plan, please let us know. **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (23rd, 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> June)**  
**Year 6**

8-9.15am	Key worker children arrive at school and enter into prearranged Hub classrooms. Year 6 Key worker children will be directed into the hall on arrival and will not go into the Hub provision as usual.
9.30am	<b>Year 6 children arrive at school.</b> Children will enter school in small groups using the car park entrance to allow for social distancing. The car park will be closed to vehicles at this time. When walking around the school site, children will be required to maintain suitable distance and clasp their hands behind their back <b>HAND WASHING upon entering school using the toilets on the Playground</b> Children will then enter the school hall and be seated in their named place with suitable distance between each child. Each child will have a personal learning pack for the week that will include all tasks and stationary required for their learning and a personal water bottle on their table. Teachers will explain procedures and expectations to children in relation to social distancing and hygiene. Bagels served to the children at tables at 9.30am from the kitchen.
10am	<b>Focussed Lesson time</b> - this will be teacher led using the resources in the learning packs Children will only move around the room to use facilities or for hand washing in order to reduce contacts with others.
11:30am	<b>HAND WASHING</b> <b>Outdoor time</b> Children to go outside on to playground- reminder to maintain distance and hands clasped behind backs when lining up and returning into school.
12:20	<b>HAND WASHING</b> <b>Lunchtime</b> Children return to their named seats in the hall for lunch which will be served to them at the tables to support social distancing and appropriate hygiene routines.
12:50/1pm	<b>HANDWASHING whilst tables are sanitised.</b> <b>Focussed Lesson time</b>
2.30	<b>HAND WASHING</b> Children to leave school through the Car Park (which will be closed to vehicles during this time). As children are Key Stage 2, they do have the option of walking home alone. If you wish to collect your child from school, please wait at the school gate at 2.30pm.
