We will also be looking at our own life journey – where have we been so far?</p> 
<p>Specific Area: Physical Development This half term we will be focusing on how to get changed for PE and looking at how we look after our bodies. In literacy we will be practising our handwriting and making sure that we get the size and shape of the letters correct – Our main focus will be curly caterpillar letters</p> 	<p>Prime Area: Communication and Language</p> <p>We will be focusing on our speaking and listening skills – taking turns to speak and listening to each other We will also be focusing on our oral blending skills and listening to sounds in words</p> 	<p>Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design Music We will be role playing different transport themes – train stations, airports and travel agents etc. We will be acting out the story of the Train Ride</p>
