


<p><b>Literacy</b> In Literacy we will be looking at fantasy texts written by C.S Lewis. Narnia is a fantastical land full of mythical creatures. Write instructions to guide Edmund to the White Witches castle help him overcome the dangers of the journey. Write a diary of Edmunds journey to the castle and his longing to be King. Plan a story based on a fantasy land of Narnia with talking beasts and seasons that change through the story.</p> 	<p><b>Maths</b> In Maths we will be focusing length, mm, Cm, and M. Discovering what the perimeter is of a 2 D shape and fractions of a set of objects and numbers. We will also be continuing to learn our 3, 4- and 8-times tables and practice our 2,5,10 from Year 2. We will regularly complete mental maths sums and problem-solving questions.</p> 	<p><b>Science</b> In science we will begin to look at the different parts of flowering plants. Explore the what a plant needs for life and growth as well as explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants.</p> 	<p><b>Computing</b> In computing we will be using power point to make a moving picture of the sleigh moving across Narnia.</p>

<p><b>Art and DT</b> In Dt we will be making Aslan masks out of Paper Mache and cardboard. Designing Narnia maps to direct Edmund to the Queens castle. Mixing primary colours to make different shades for Aslan's mane.</p> 	<p><b>PE.</b> In PE we will practicing football skills such as dribbling, controlling the ball and passing to a partner.</p> 	<p><b>French –</b> In French we will give and respond to simple classroom instructions, identify colours and numbers.</p> 	<p><b>RE</b> In R.E we will be describing some ways that Christians show their faith. We will also be looking at reasons why being a Christian is a good thing in Britain today, and two reasons why it might be hard sometimes.</p>
<p><b>Home learning – With the pandemic, we really need your support in helping your children to catch up with their learning. Please read below to see what we need from you.</b></p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Children will be expected to read their home reading books three times a week with a written comment from a parent in their reading record. They will need a school book bag and reading record. Book bags are available from the school office. Books will be changed every Friday. If children haven't read three times at home, we will read in the library at break or dinner time.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Children will have a times table sheet sent home every week. Children will be tested on these at some stage throughout the week.</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b> We will do a weekly spelling test every Wednesday. Children will be given a new spelling sheet to practise their spellings every week.</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> At the end of every term we will have a showcase day, where children can present a project they have worked on for the topic. For example, Draw/paint a picture of the beach in spring using different textures. Look at different pants growing and find out what they are? How do you know spring is happening in your area</p>
