



### Literacy

In literacy we will continue to practise our handwriting and make sure that we get the size and shape of the letters correct. We will be taking ourselves on a 'journey' with the famous book by Aaron Becker. We will be really focusing on our year 2 grammar skills and preparing for writing in year 3.



### Maths

In maths we will be focusing on division, statistics, shape and fractions. We will be testing our Stickability with some difficult topics but coming through with lots of new learning and problem solving techniques. We will be focusing on word based problems to we know how to read, understand and calculate word problems.



### Science
